The chamber's beloved signature annual fundraiser, "The Auction: Charity Gala & Dinner Affair." returns on Friday. September 29 this year with a goal of helping a local small business owner reach the dream of "home."

Member non-profit Habitat for Humanity Knoxville was selected as a first time recipient of 20% of all item sales and 20% of net operating proceeds from the auction. Specifically, the portion of funds raised from this year's auction will help finish a house build for local small business owners Jose and Jessica and their four children. Despite being the definition of hard workers, changes to the Knoxville area's



housing affordability have kept a safe home of their own just out of reach.

As the longest standing fundraiser event since 1987, The Auction allows the chamber to continue to grow and expand its programs and services to members at no added cost to them, continually increasing the value of membership for small and local businesses. The auction also helps support the chamber's Continued Development Grant program reimbursing member businesses up to \$500 for education and training expenses.

Businesses can help and can enjoy added promotion of their brand in a number of ways such as sponsorship and item donation. Sponsorships are still available at three levels, with industry exclusivity only offered to the top two levels.
